

# Wednesday Virtual Learning Day Expectations for Middle School Staff and Families

## STAFF EXPECTATIONS

- Staff will be working in the physical building during the virtual days.
- Teachers in grades 6–8 will use Schoology.
- All asynchronous lessons will be posted each day on Schoology at least 24 hours prior to the due dates. These lessons will include instructional videos as well as activities to practice skills, reinforce concepts, and/or deepen understanding.
- Classroom teachers are expected to provide meaningful instruction with the whole class (or in small groups) during their assigned block as they would in the physical building during each period. See schedule below. This time will be used for check-ins, addressing students' questions/further explanations, and providing feedback.
