

Common Return to School Practices for ALL Elementary Schools

(Additional information related to each specific school will be sent to all families from the school principal)

- Rooms
 - Cleaning chemicals/supplies must not be accessible to students.
Teachers will have the option to clean desks and manipulatives during the day.
 - Priority cleaning on high touch surfaces (desks, tables, etc).
 - Students will go to gym/music/art/library areas for instruction.
 - Student study carrels / partitions are being purchased for classroom use.
 - Hand sanitizers will be distributed throughout the building.
 - Support staff schedules will be simplified as much as possible to reduce the number of student interactions.
 - Outdoor learning spaces used whenever possible to give students & staff a break from wearing masks.
 - **Social distancing will NOT be realistically maintained at all times.**
 - Teachers will look for opportunities to use outdoor and larger indoor spaces to give students a break from masks.

- Lunch
 - Social distancing - we will do the best we can
 - Four to six students per table in a zig-zag pattern
 - Painters tape to mark 6 feet spaces for lunch lines and near bathrooms.
 - Masks will be removed so students can eat and drink.

- Student Materials Drop Off
 - Scheduled during the week prior to school in two sessions based on students' last name (A-L & M-Z).

- Recess
 - Equipment Cleaning
 - Masks will not be required - social distance as much as possible

- Virtual Instruction / Daily Schedule (Slides 12-16 in each elementary plan)
 - Teacher will provide a daily schedule for a virtual classroom
 - Student attendance will be required.
 - Specials - determinations will be made depending on the number of students going virtual.
